

## Boston Therapeutic Endoscopy Course 2011 at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center

A specialized endoscopy course, designed for gastroenterologists, surgical endoscopists, and gastroenterology fellows Friday, October 21 and Saturday, October 22. Live transmission from the Berenson Center for Advanced Endoscopy at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center and state-of-the-art lectures will cover advanced techniques in GI endoscopy.

This year we are offering a full day of live cases and lectures, a pancreatic cysts symposium and fellows ercp and advanced techniques workshop.

At the conclusion of the live cases and lectures the participant should be able to determine indications and contraindications for advanced endoscopic procedures, describe the role of endoscopy in the management of gastrointestinal disease and assess new technology in digestive disease management.

At the conclusion of the pancreatic cyst symposium the participant should be able to identify a radiologist's perspective of cystic lesions of the pancreas, determine the natural history of a small pancreatic cyst, and comprehend cyst fluid analysis.

At the conclusion of the fellows ercp and advanced techniques session the participant should be able to discuss indications for various ERCP/EUS techniques perform ERCP/EUS procedures in hands-on session with models, and identify complications associated with ERCP/EUS procedures.
